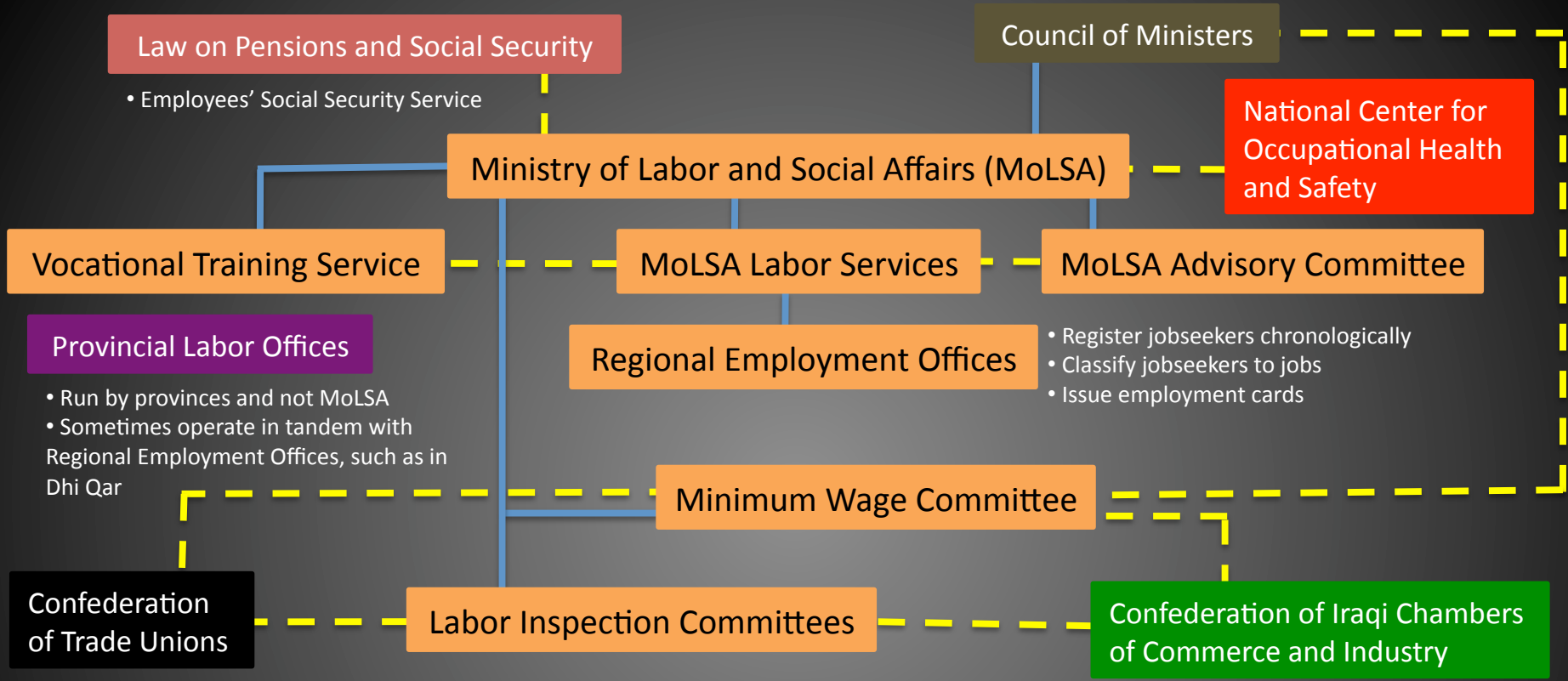


Labor Oversight in Iraq, per the Iraq Labor Code of 1987 and its Amendments



Provincial Labor Offices

- Run by provinces and not MoLSA
- Sometimes operate in tandem with Regional Employment Offices, such as in Dhi Qar

- Register jobseekers chronologically
- Classify jobseekers to jobs
- Issue employment cards

Confederation of Trade Unions

- General Federation of Iraqi Workers (GFIW)
- Federation of Oil Unions in Iraq
- Iraqi Engineers Union
- Syndicate Union of Kurdistan Workers
- Teachers' Union in Iraq
- Journalists' Union
- Carpenters' Union
- Journeymen Electricians' Union

Notes:

“The Labor Services of the Ministry of Labor and Social Affairs shall be responsible, through its employment offices, for organizing the placement of workers in relation to available jobs and in such a way as to achieve equity and equality between workers.”

“Instructions issued by the Ministry of Labor and Social Affairs shall determine the occupations for which training is to be provided, the period of training for each occupation, the amount of compensation to be granted to trainees, the curricula in relation to theoretical and practical knowledge...”
